Just outside Brønnøysund lies the beautiful islands of Vega.

This wonderful cultural landscape was inscribed on UNESCO's World Heritage List in 2004. The basis of the status is the Islanders outstanding tradition of keeping wild eider ducks as pets.

A visit to Vega World Heritage Centre at Gardsøy Vega, will give you a journey through the history of the Vega archipelago, from Stone Age settlements to modern Vega.

It will also give you an insight to the 1500 years old practice of tending eider ducks. A tradition which seeks to continue the unique interplay between eider ducks and eider tenders.

Come visit the World Heritage Centre and learn about how tending eiders and the fishing farmers way of life led to a World Heritage status.

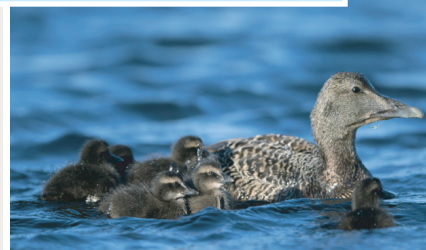
