ABOUT

STØTT Brygge is located at the far northern edge of the Helgeland coast, where the Vestfjord opens toward Lofoten. This 19th-century trading post has been restored room by room – the Bakery, Fisherman's Cabin, Storehouse, and Old Shop – offering a rare mix of gracious comfort and authentic coastal culture. There are 16 guest rooms (34 beds) across three buildings.

Food is central to the experience. In Restaurant Gammelbutikken, which also houses a small fisheries museum upstairs, a three-course menu is served daily in summer – often featuring house-made stockfish. Outside summer, the venue hosts private events such as weddings and corporate gatherings with sea views. The facility is Eco-Lighthouse certified, sourcing ingredients from local fishermen, farms, and seaweed foragers.

Activities range from guided kayaking and RIB tours to relaxed history walks on nearby Svenningen. STØTT is also a hub for day trips to Svartisen glacier, Rødøyløva mountain, and the island of Myken.

Getting here is easier than expected: just under 70 minutes by express boat from Bodø, or by charter, seaplane, or helicopter. The welcome is warm, the surroundings quiet, and the experience deeply rooted in place.
