Join us at Kaffekollektivet, situated in one of Træna's first fish processing plants, for an intimate encounter with the island's heritage. Located right on the water's edge, this historic venue sets the stage for a unique storytelling session led by a local seaweed harvester and archaeologist.

Discover the art of sustainable seaweed harvesting. You will learn how these "vegetables of the sea" are hand-picked during the cold winter and spring months and get to taste a specially prepared seaweed dish that showcases the delicate flavours of the Arctic.

To complete the experience, we serve freshly brewed coffee from the neighbouring island of Lovund and a sweet local treat. While you enjoy the local flavours in the rustic atmosphere of the old wharf, your host will delve into the world of archaeology.

Kranberget houses a small, exclusive exhibition featuring authentic finds from the most recent excavations on the island of Sanna. Hear the fascinating stories of these ancient treasures and gain a rare insight into how people have lived and thrived on the edge of the ocean for over 9,000 years.
